



Call for Contributions

<u>UNIC</u> is an alliance of ten universities rooted in ten post-industrial cities,¹ facing challenges—and opportunities—derived from migration, economic crises, digitalisation, sustainability and risk, among others. Its mission is: boosting development of knowledge through co-creation and collaboration, innovation and inclusion. It aspires to have positive societal impact.

To further this mission, we are now calling for **contributions on any area of Transnational Screens** (including but not restricted to: **film and TV, streaming, games, mobile media, digital education** etc) from academics in UNIC and/or other HEIs in the UNIC cities, that align with the following key thematic lines:

- 1. Contextualising Cultural Heritage: Exploring Digital innovation and Diverse Perspectives in Post-Industrial Cities
- 2. Deconstructing Superdiversity: Conceptualisations, Contestations and Challenges
- 3. Reimagining Urban Resilience: Participatory Frameworks and the Wise City
- 4. Confronting Systemic Inequalities: Justice, Security, and Institutional Reforms
- 5. Redefining Sustainability with Adaptability: Balancing Social, Economic, and Environmental Dimensions
- 6. Innovating with Purpose: Aligning Teaching and Learning with Community Needs and Challenges

Accepted contributions will be published on a Special Issue of the Routledge Journal *Transnational Screens*, guest-edited by Claire Dorrity and Maroun Tabal, that will be devoted to post-industrial cities in transition. We are inviting:

- Research articles: between 5,000 and 7,000 words
- Case Studies: 3,000 to 4,000 words
- Video or photo essays, submitted with a 1,000 to 1,500 word introduction
- Conference/Symposia/Event/Festival Reviews: 900 to 1,000 words

We are particularly interested in **co-authored contributions** by staff from two or more of the HEIs or cities in the UNIC network; contributions co-authored with **students as partners (or community members)**; contributions related to Virtual Exchange, also known as Collaborative Online International Learning **VE/COIL**.
