LOCAL ANNEX – UNIVERSITY OF DEUSTO

Four UNIC CityLab Awards will be distributed among all UNIC universities for the duration of UNIC 2.0 funding.

The University of Deusto will only pay the UNIC CityLabs Awards to its academics with valid contracts at the time the awards are used.

A limited amount of funds is allocated for this action, and not all presented initiatives may be awarded.

The maximum grant amount will be €500 for each award.

Out of the categories established in the general call, the grant can only be used for expenditures with the following specific conditions:

Budget Usage:

The Erasmus Project Management Unit (UGPE), responsible for the UNIC project's financial part, will approve the use of the budget and manage it directly. Expenses incurred outside this channel will not be reimbursed.

The budget will cover the following types of expenses to support academic outputs¹ related to the following fields of knowledge: ***Urban resilience, sustainability and the future of inclusive post-industrial societies:***

- Translation / proofreading services
- Editing services
- Publication costs
- Attendance to workshops, trainings and conferences
- Registration fees to present the academic output

Please note that the following costs will be considered ineligible:

- Equipment
- Consumables

Subcontracting is not allowed.
